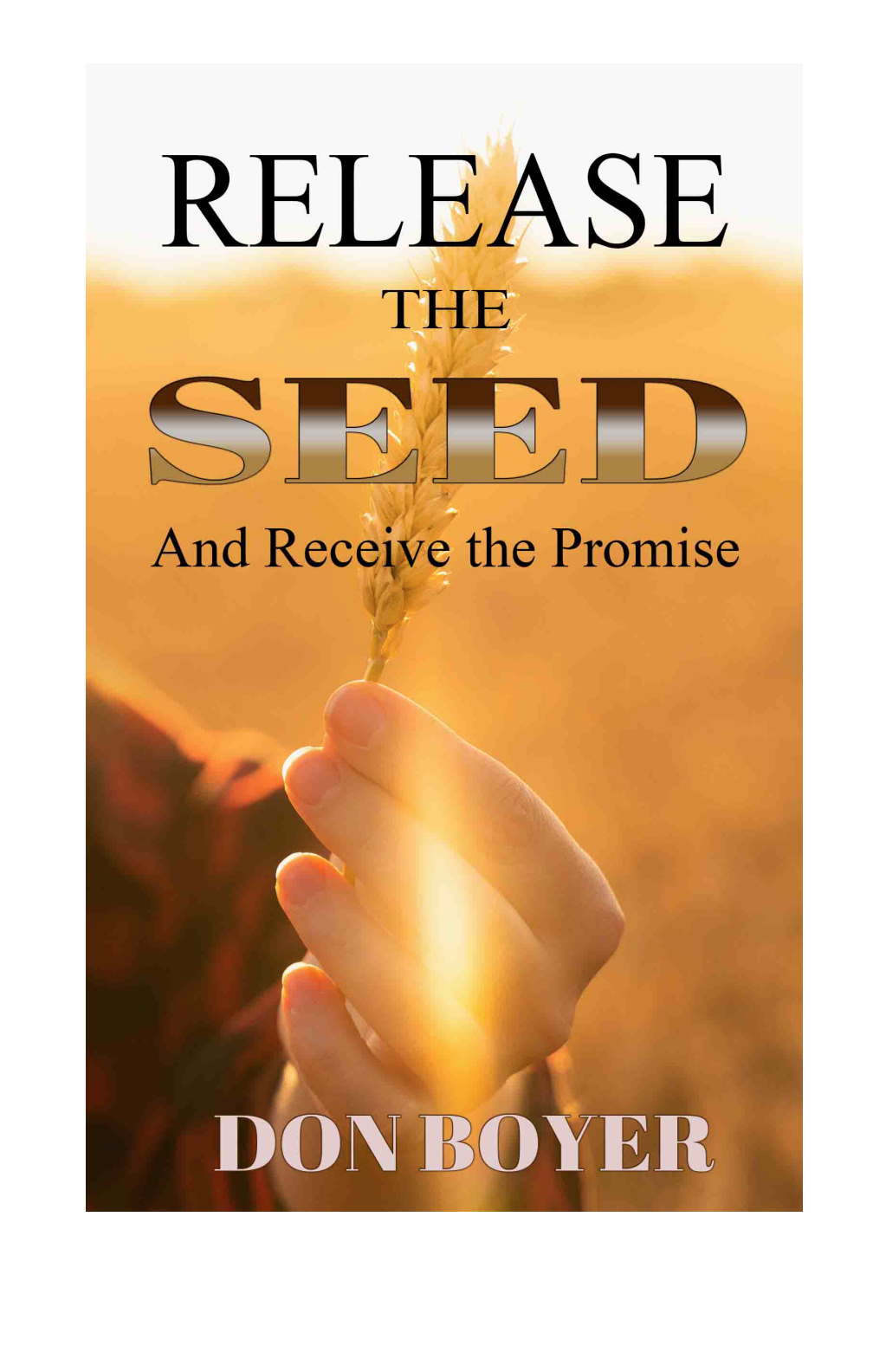

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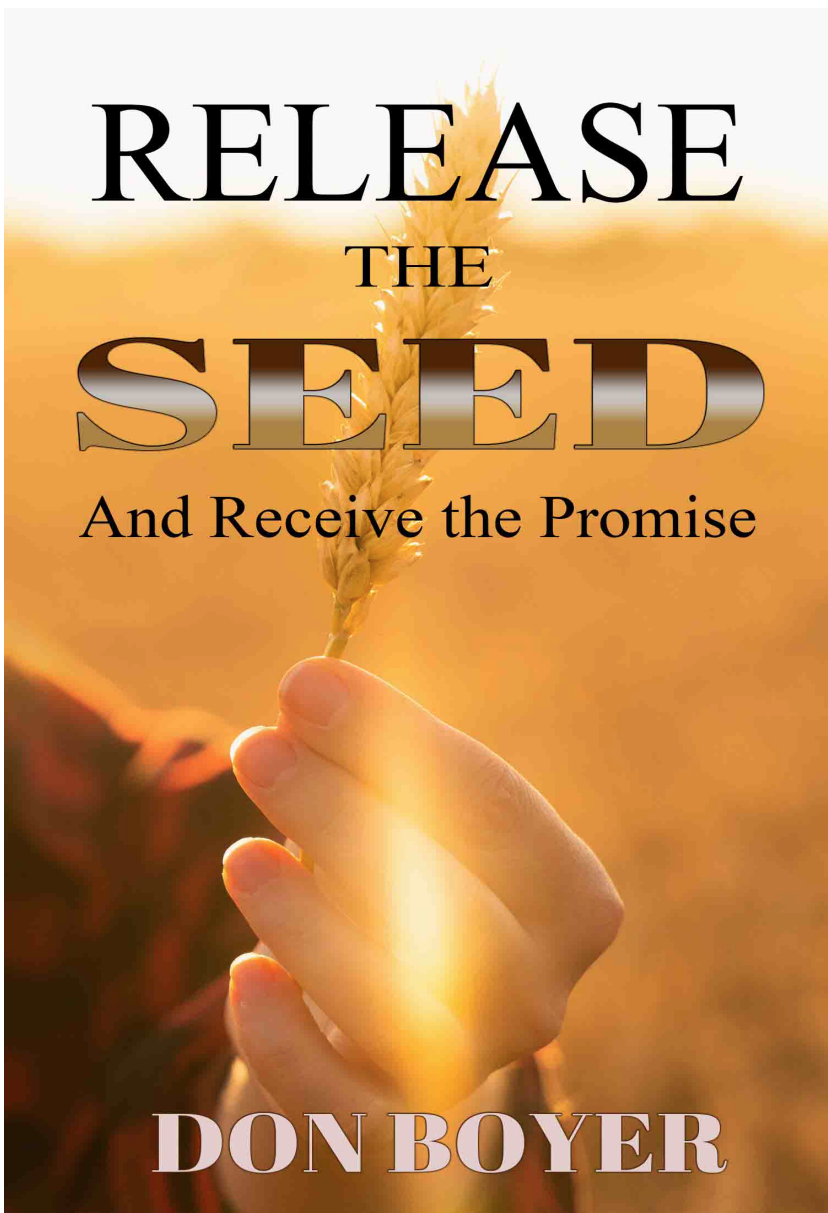

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INTRODUCTION

Why I Wrote this Book

“To step into the office and anointing of a financial deliverer and teach biblical prosperity, you have to know without a shadow of a doubt that this is your assignment or be completely insane.”

My mentor once said, “Any pastor who focuses on financial deliverance sets in motion a systematic and methodical effort to destroy his credibility in that city.”

What is a Financial Deliverer?

However, to those who are bound and locked in the prison of poverty, a financial deliverer is the golden key that unlocks those prison doors and sets them free.

If you ever felt the pain and anguish of losing your home, losing your car, losing your savings, or losing your business, you cannot help having a healthy hatred for lack and poverty.

I did not write this book for those who sneer and laugh at the prosperity message or for those who get angry at this message and call it false doctrine. I wrote this book for those whose mind is tormented because of financial pressure, for those who have experienced the unbearable pain of having their home go into foreclosure or their car repossessed, for those who don't have the money to stop the hounding creditors, and for those who do not have enough money to take care of the needs of their family.

It was during a time of extreme transition that God took me on a 60-day intensive inner dialog that I can only relate to what Jacob must have felt like when his encounter with God resulted in his hip being dislocated.

In that 60-day experience the Lord took me on, He gave me my 5 assignments, one in which He commissioned me to *“Teach My people how to get (experience) a Financial Miracle Harvest.”* It was the start of my entrance into the office and anointing of a financial deliverer. Whenever God is going to bring about a magnificent miracle or miraculous change in your life, He first sends a messenger with a message into your life.

He sent Phillip to the eunuch in the desert, Peter to Cornelius

on a rooftop, and Elijah to a destitute widow. We could fill an entire chapter with all the accounts that record a messenger with a message sent to someone for the sole purpose of being the pathway to a miracle.

I am well aware of what is required to walk in the office of one who teaches biblical prosperity but also know the joy of what it is like to see the Lord set free the financially captive. Those who complain that all the preacher does is talk about money are not truly aware of the pain and devastation of poverty.

"And God blessed them, and God said unto them, "Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth..."
Genesis 1:28 KJV

2010 marked the year that we entered into the dimension and plane of replenishing our territory and taking dominion over our finances and global wealth.

"We Have Entered into the Season of Sowing"

We have now entered into a new season; we have entered a season of sowing. The time for reckless spending has passed; we must now focus on accurate, consistent sowing. In the season of abundant flow, we allow our spending to move money away from us in exchange for present comfort; in the season of sowing, we cause financial abundance to flow to us for future provision. A few nights ago, as I was praying in the early hours before dawn, the Lord spoke into my heart and said the word "replenish."

It was a direct word, but I really did not know what He meant and had no direction on how to apply it. A few days passed, and although I still did not have any direction on the word

“replenish,” it kept lingering in the back of my mind and amid my heart.

Prophetic Word for Today and the Coming Years

Then on Sunday, August 1, 2010, at 7: 04 p.m., God spoke to me again, telling me that the word “replenish” was the new season of sowing we are now in, and He showed me the following things:

1. We have now entered into the season of sowing and have left the season of spending. Those who will prosper in these harsh economic times, which is a global attack on the world’s finances, will have to enter and partake of this new season of sowing. Now is the time to sow every dollar you can, instead of spending your money on unhealthy food and items that you will never use. Use that money to sow to ensure an abundant harvest that you will desperately need in the coming years. Those who choose to ignore the season of sowing and continue in the season of uncontrolled, reckless spending will face economic destruction in the near future.
2. Those who enter into the season of sowing will experience abundant provision during this global financial famine and will be abundantly rewarded (made extremely wealthy) when “My people enter the season of harvest that is coming in these last days.”
3. We have now begun to enter into the season of the transference of wealth from the world’s system into the possession of the righteous who are prepared (and qualified) to receive it.

Now is the Time to Invest in Your Future by Sowing in Your Present

What does it mean to enter into the season of sowing and leave the season of spending? It simply means that you start investing in your future by sowing seed in your present.

We were able to publish 19 books that put 200,000 copies in the marketplace worldwide and produce 3 movies. The results of those projects allowed us to build a worldwide following and generate hundreds of thousands of dollars in revenue.

And then one day, the Lord spoke to me and said, "It's time to leave this season as you now know it." Now, I knew for two and half years that my time in this season was over, but because I did not have any direction, I stayed faithful, even though my season was over and I felt as dry as a bone.

What I was practicing without knowing it was the first law of survival when you are lost in the wilderness: **Stay put and help will find you.**

As it was, during that two and half year wait, I did take a wrong path and opened a third business. Although God blessed and prospered the business venture, it cost us the loss of a friendship with two very dear friends due to a business dispute and misunderstanding.

When God spoke to me and told me it was time to leave my season, I said, "Lord why didn't you tell me this two and a half years ago?" His response was, "If I would have told you then, you would have chosen to go in the wrong direction."

Like Joseph, you have to go through some things to prepare you for your assignment.

Because I waited and followed His direction, He gave me my perfect assignment and calling to be in His perfect will and timing. His perfect will is always to position you to be in the best possible place to receive the maximum amount of blessing!

Although it is never pleasant, the death of a season ushers in a new season of glorious expansion of favor, blessing, prosperity, and promotion.

Sometimes you must go through the darkest time of your life in order to enter into the most glorious time of your life.

Joseph had to pass through the dark time of prison in order to enter into the glorious palace of Egypt.

Daniel had to face the lion's den on his way up to kingship prominence.

The three Hebrew children had to walk out of a fiery furnace in order to walk into kingdom promotion.

Jacob had to face complete loss and extreme financial desperation before he held the position of being the wealthiest man in the land.

Joshua endured years of faithful service to Moses before being promoted to captain and general of God's chosen people.

Perhaps this day finds you under financial pressure or enduring uncertainty about the direction the Lord is leading you. One thing you can count on is the changing of seasons; and if you enter into this season of sowing, you will be positioning yourself to not only change your current financial crises, but also to partake of this massive harvest coming your way.

As I shared with you in the introduction, for one to enter into the office and calling of a financial deliverer and teach biblical prosperity, one has to know without a shadow of a doubt that this is their calling and assignment or be completely insane or a complete nut, for the price of this anointing and office can only be paid by one who is truly called.

*"Now Joseph had a dream, and he told it to his brothers,

The dream Joseph had was for the future salvation and provision for his brothers during a future famine that was coming to the land. This message I am sharing with you to enter the season of sowing is for your financial salvation and provision during the famine that is now upon us and will be before us in the coming years.

The Joseph Principle

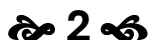

PROSPERITY IS IN YOUR HAND

Everyone is always looking for the key, the secret, and the means to prosperity and financial increase. Too often, we think prosperity is a mystery or unsolvable puzzle locked within the Word of God that we just cannot figure out.

We look for a secret code or a divine message to unlock the unlimited wealth that God promises us in His Word. We look for it everywhere but in the right place. Prayer and fasting, as important as they are, are not what unlocks the flow of prosperity into your life. What brings about prosperity in your life is what is found within your hand.

Since the ability to create prosperity is in your hand, it also means that the amount of prosperity is within your control.

What is in your hand? Seed.

God puts seed into your hand for the purpose of sowing it to receive a harvest and to perpetuate prosperity in your life.

2 Corinthians 9:10

The Power of the Seed Contains the Promise of the Harvest.

Release the seed and receive the promise. There is nothing secret about that. There is no biblical secret you must unlock —

simply plant the seed and you put the harvest cycle into motion.

**“Seed is given in order to unlock the door
of provision and abundance.”**

The fact is you control the amount and degree of prosperity you will have in your lifetime, not God. He provided the system of increase for you called Seedtime and Harvest in the beginning of creation and then made a covenant with the seed to ensure it for as long as the earth remains.

Genesis 1:11 Genesis 8:22

The Embedded Code in Every Seed

Each seed has within it an embedded code to not only reproduce after its kind, but to reproduce in a multiple number. You do not have to try to make the seed reproduce or multiply; those instructions are already embedded in them by the hand of God. “For the earth yields crops by itself: first the blade, then the head, after that the full grain in the head.” Mk.4:28

God does not put a cap or ceiling on the amount of prosperity you experience in your lifetime; He supplies the means, which is the seed, He provides the system, which is planting the seed, He provides the results by multiplying the seed that has been planted and calls it a harvest but leaves the amount you sow up to you. 2 Co.23 9:6

One of the greatest blessings God can give you is not a one-time Supernatural Harvest, but a lifetime revelation of the power of a seed. Once you understand the power, potential, and purpose of a seed, your days of financial lack and struggle will be over.

The seed works to reproduce itself. Just look at every kind of herb on earth—we know that the seed multiplies itself

(produces a harvest)—just look at any crop in a farmer’s field. The only question left is, “How much seed are you planting?”

No amount of praying, fasting, begging, complaining, or crying will change this fact. Prosperity is not given because we need it; it is given because we deserve it.

How do we deserve it? By sowing seed.

We qualify to deserve prosperity and increase (harvest) when we adhere to the law of planting. I can tell you the size and consistency of the harvest in your future by looking at the size and consistency of your planting in the present. The power of a (financial) seed is your pathway out of lack, limitation, and poverty. It is your roadmap to a lifetime of abundance and increase.

Why then doesn’t everyone use this system to eliminate lack and create increase? Because of Seedtime and Harvest; it is called Seedtime and Harvest because...

“Seed Takes Time to Produce into a Harvest.”

When you plant a seed, whether it is a natural seed or financial seed, it takes a certain amount of time to multiply and be ready for harvest. How long does it take for a financial seed to go from planting to harvest? That part varies, and it is only problematic for the sporadic sower or the first-time sower who is under financial pressure.

Our God is a merciful God, and the infinite times that He delivers us out of financial jams through a miracle harvest and a rapid harvest cannot be numbered.

However, there are times when, due to our negligence of sowing seed consistently, we will have to suffer the agony and pain of waiting for our harvest to come. But rest assured, if that

is the case, God will give you the grace, peace, and strength to make it through to harvest time.

“When you allow fear to keep you from sowing in the present, lack takes control of your future.”

You can dig yourself out of every dark financial hole you find yourself in; you can make it out of any financial storm you may face with the power of a (financial) seed. A planted seed under the right conditions will always multiply and bring forth a harvest. I find it interesting that God didn't send a basket of food or a miracle check in the mail to a pallid, impoverished peasant woman who was about to eat her last meal with her son, who is on his death bed.

She was at the end of her rope and desperately in need of provision, yet God did not send her what she thought she needed.

What did God send to deliver her out of a financial death trap? A hungry preacher with an opportunity to sow a seed! To the reasoning mind, that sounds crazy, but that was exactly the plan to deliver her and give her an instant harvest of increase. 1 Kings 17:14

I remember when we started our publishing company, and I was gathering all our money for capital. Then God spoke to me and said, “Sow a thousand-dollar seed.” I said, “Lord, please not now, not that; I need a thousand dollars. I don't need to be giving away a thousand dollars right now.” I was driving up to a burger place when the Lord started dealing with me on this, and by the time I got to the window to get my food, my stomach was so upset I couldn't even enjoy my burger.

However, I knew He was right and that He was giving me the key to create a very successful publishing business, which was

my goal. Once I gave in and said yes, my peace came back ... and I had the best tasting burger ever! The very next day, I released my seed, and the harvest from that thousand-dollar seed created hundreds of thousands of dollars in book sales over the next 36 months. The Reasoning Mind

When you are facing financial challenges, the last thing your carnal reasoning mind wants you to do is sow seed. You will be moved by the Lord to plant a seed. You know within your heart that is the right thing to do, and your faith and expectations are high for a miracle harvest. Then just as you are about to pull out your checkbook, your reasoning mind pops up and says,

“Have you lost your mind? Did your brain just melt inside your skull and leak out your left ear or something? You know that guy is going to use your money to buy a new Mercedes and expensive jewelry for his wife. Besides that, you got bills up the yin yang; you can’t afford to sow right now!”

This is why the Bible tells us to renew our mind in Romans 12:2. The reasoning (carnal mind) will rob you blind and keep you stuck in poverty and lack.

Five Things to Understand about the Reasoning Mind

1. The reasoning mind will always take the side of why it is right to do the wrong thing. It will convince you that doing the right thing is the wrong thing to do.
2. The reasoning mind will cheat you out of every blessing God has promised you. It will always defeat you spiritually.

3. The reasoning mind will get you in trouble.
4. The reasoning mind is founded upon limited data.
5. The reasoning mind cannot understand the supernatural thoughts and methods of God. God's ways do not make sense to the natural mind.

If you are going to release your seed and receive a financial harvest, you are going to have to overcome your natural reasoning mind. You do that by feeding on the Word of God daily, sometimes hourly when you are going through a severe financial storm.

Release the seed you have in your hand, and God will release the harvest He has in His hand.

Nine parts of these anointing God controls; one part of the anointing you control.

6. Talents, skills, abilities, and gifts will blossom, Daniel 1:17
7. Divine connections, Acts 7:9-10

Financial expansion under the millionaire anointing will cause you to grow; however, here is what you need to know:

*"Growth is never easy, usually challenging,
and sometimes painful."*

A million-dollar income is available to everyone, but it is not for everyone. Wealth is not for the faint in heart, but the mature in character.

Peculiar Financial Anointing

Many people in the Bible had the millionaire anointing, but we are only going to look at eight of them.

Abraham

"The Lord has blessed my master greatly, and he has become great; and He has given him flocks and herds, silver and gold, male and female servants, and camels and donkeys." Genesis 24:35

Isaac

"The man began to prosper and continued prospering until he became very prosperous; for he had possessions of flocks and possessions of herds and a great number of servants." Genesis 26:13-14

Jacob

“Thus the man became exceedingly prosperous, and had large flocks, female and male servants, and camels and donkeys.” Genesis 30:43

Joseph

“The Lord was with Joseph, and he was a successful man; and he was in the house of his master, the Egyptian.” Genesis 39:2

Job

“Also his possessions were seven thousand sheep, three thousand camels, five hundred yoke of oxen, five hundred female donkeys, and a very large household, so that this man was the greatest of all the people of the East.” Job 1:3

David

“Wealth and riches will be in his house, and his righteousness endures forever.” Psalm 112:3

Solomon

“So the Lord exalted Solomon exceedingly in the sight of all Israel. And bestowed on him such royal majesty as had not been on any king before him in Israel.” I Chronicles 29:25

The 10 Blessings and Promises of the Millionaire Anointing

1. Supernatural insights, ideas, and problem-solving ability

Our income always reflects the problems we resolve. A janitor earns \$15 an hour to solve trash problems; a doctor earns \$300 an hour for solving health problems. The bigger the problems you solve, the higher pay you will earn.

Joseph solved problems for Potiphar, the warden of the prison, the butler in prison, and eventually for Pharaoh himself. His reward for solving the problems of Pharaoh was untold honor, respect, riches, and wealth. As this anointing begins to operate in your life, you will begin to get money-making ideas and insights for inventions, businesses, and ways to make life easier for people and solve their problems.

The story is told that at the turn of the century when Coca-Cola was still being served from drug store fountains, a man walked into their office and was paid a million dollars for two words: "Bottle it." That is how Coca-Cola went from being sold from drug store fountains to being sold in bottles in stores. Billionaire Ross Perot said that a good idea can allow you to live like a king for the rest of your life. Under the Millionaire Anointing, God floods our minds with million-dollar ideas. The key is to move upon them by taking action.

2. Undeniable favor

Undeniable favor is favor that keeps showing up and that others can see. Everywhere you go, everywhere you turn, favor shows up. It will seem uncanny at first, but you will

start seeing doors open for you, people wanting to do things for you, and you'll find that merchandise is on sale when they ring up your purchase.

These events do not just show up once or occasionally; they start showing up daily. Undeniable favor is a force from heaven that comes to earth on your behalf. It is God orchestrating events, places, time, dates, and people to be in a position to bless and increase you. Favor is not something you create; it is something you experience. When undeniable favor begins to operate in your life, everyone around you will be able to see it, and it will be completely undeniable that you are blessed and well favored.

3. Wisdom and discernment

Small insights can create big changes. In real estate, knowing where to build a house makes the same house worth \$200,000 in one location and one million dollars in another location. Knowing when to say yes and when to say no has created fortunes and saved fortunes. What made Daniel so attractive to the king was that Daniel had both wisdom and discernment. The Holy Spirit is given to us to lead and guide us into the truth.

4. Knowledge and understanding

Knowledge is the accumulation of insight and information, and understanding is the application of that knowledge. The Bible exhorts us to be “doers of the Word, and not hearers only.” The wise man built his house upon a rock and withstood the storms that beat against it. The unwise man built his house upon the sand, and when the storm came, it destroyed it. The wise man hears the Word and

does it; the unwise man hears the Word and takes no action on it. Matt.7:26

5. Financial increase

The common denominator of all those who operate under God's blessing is financial increase. The Bible records in Proverbs 15:6, "In the house of the righteous there is much treasure."

6. Talents and skills

As you begin to operate under this anointing, you will find that God begins to accelerate your work skills, talents, and abilities in the workplace and marketplace. "Because that for this thing the Lord thy God shall bless you in all your works, and in all that you put your hand to." Deuteronomy 15:10

7. Divine connections

It only takes one key person to open the doors that will give you a lifetime of riches. It happened for Joseph when he interpreted the dream for Pharaoh, for Daniel when he showed himself as an example of wisdom before Nebuchadnezzar, and for Rebekah when Abraham's servant went seeking a wife for Issac. Genesis 24:45

8. Supernatural promotions

When God decides to promote you, no one or anything can get in your way or stop that promotional blessing. 9. Extraordinary visionary

The one common thing that all major successful and wealthy people have in common is the ability to spot trends before they erupt in the marketplace. Bill Gates was a perfect example of this when he realized that the PC would change how the entire world operates. This is called being an Extraordinary Visionary. “And I will give you treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that you may know that I, the Lord, which call you by your name, am the God of Israel.” Isaiah 45:3

10. Hands to create wealth

This is the one and only part of the millionaire anointing that you bring to the table. In Deuteronomy 8:18, God tells us that “it is He that gives you power to get wealth.” How does He do that? Does He give you super fast hands so that you can flip burgers faster than anyone else? Does He make you the fastest salesperson in the world, beating your competition to the marketplace? No, He empowers us with the ability to sow seed. “But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.” 2 Corinthians 9:6

HOW TO RECEIVE A MIRACLE HARVEST

When I look at all the pain and suffering that comes as a direct result of lack and poverty, it is heart wrenching. The most painful thing about poverty is that it is totally unnecessary. It is unnecessary because God gives us seed to plant that multiplies and produces a harvest.

*"Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food,
supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits
of your righteousness."*

2 Co. 9:10 NKJV

God is always faithful to supply us with seed to plant so that we can have a harvest of increase and enter a lifestyle of abundance, instead of living a life of lack.

The problem with many people is that they do not recognize the seed God gives them; they consume or spend the seed that God gives them or just plain fail to plant the seed that God provides for them. When you sow your seed, it puts into motion the miracle process of the multiplying of your seed to create financial increase and expansion in your life.

There have been many times that I have experienced the pressure of financial challenges, times when I've felt the effects of a bad economy and seasons of financial heartache. In every instance, two major factors have always been present:

1. The financial crises that came into my life were due to me becoming complacent and slothful in my giving (sowing).
2. I was always able to turn those conditions around and create financial abundance through the power of sowing seed once again.

When I began to sow seed again, I instantly put into motion the miracle process of financial increase; of course, I still had to pay the uncomfortable price of financial pressure while my seed was in the ground and growing, but the harvest always came.

**“What is the miracle behind our giving?
God multiplying our seed.”**

The miracle process of God multiplying our seed is God using His unlimited power, resources, ability, and means to get financial increase and expansion to enter our life. God has no problem, limitation, or barriers multiplying the seed that we sow. This is what Paul was talking about in 2 Co. 9:8:

“And God is able to make all grace (Greek-earthly blessings) abound towards you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.”

NKJV

If you find yourself in debt, under financial pressure and struggles, you can “give” (sow) your way out of it. It only takes a seed to start the process, and God will even supply you with that seed!

7 Steps to a Miracle Harvest

1. **Decide Your Harvest:** Give your seed an instruction of what kind of harvest you want it to produce. Do not look at a need as a need; view it as a harvest. If you have a need of \$5,000, don't view it as a need, see it as a harvest! When God created seed in the beginning, He gave each seed an assignment. Gen.1:11. God allows you to sow seed of what you do have in order to create a harvest of something you don't have.
2. **Sow Your Seed:** Sowing seed begins the miracle process of financial increase. Once you plant your seed, everything starts to move into divine motion and God at once begins the miracle process of multiplying your seed.

Once you make the decision to sow your seed, it is very important you follow through with your intent and actually release your seed. Many good harvests have been missed because of a lack of follow through on good intentions. You may be at church intending to sow your seed and realize you are down to your last check, so you decide you will put it in on Sunday. From the time you leave to the time Sunday comes around, something came up and you used that seed on other things.

"And in this, I give advice: It is to your advantage not only to be doing what you began and were desiring to do a year ago; but now you must also complete the doing of it; that as there was a readiness to desire it, so there also may be a completion out of what you have."

2Co.8:10-11

I remember years ago my daughter, when she was eight years old, did some work around the house and earned ten

dollars. Later that day, she came to me and said, “Daddy, can I have an offering envelope so I can pay my tithes?” As she opened the envelope, she put in three quarters. I said, “Nom honey; it’s four quarters you need to put in.” She gave me a serious look and said, “I know, but I was outside playing, and I lost God’s quarter!”

The harvest stays locked inside your seed until it is planted in the ground. When your seed is planted, it releases the harvest. An unplanted seed will be the most it can ever be, until it is planted and then becomes all that it was designed to be.

“If I do my part of sowing seed, I know God will do His part of multiplying that seed into a harvest.”

3. **Water the Seed:** Add faith to your seed. There is only one way to build faith, and that is by hearing the Word of God. God’s Word is the only thing that produces faith in our life. Roman 10:17 says:

*“So then faith comes by hearing,
and hearing by the Word of God.”*

Therefore, it is imperative that you read, study, and meditate upon the scriptures that have to do with financial promises on a daily and consistent basis.

By doing this, you are getting the Word of God into your heart and keeping it there. This process is called watering the seed. Getting God’s Word into your heart and keeping it there is the only thing that will produce faith.

In order for you to receive your harvest, you must add faith to your seed. If you fail to add faith to your seed, you will forfeit your harvest like our Old Testament forefathers; Hebrews 4: 2 says:

“For indeed the gospel was preached to us, as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in those who heard it.”

When you are under severe financial pressure, it is very hard to proclaim, confess, and believe promises of prosperity. The ear-numbing boom of overdue bills and financial lack is so loud it causes our heart to faint. What is the answer? As we saw earlier, the only way faith comes is by hearing the Word of God, getting it into our heart, and keeping it there.

What is faith? “It is the supernatural ability to believe God.” Faith is your ability to believe God beyond your ability to believe God. It is not in the natural ability of mankind to believe God or have faith, especially when man’s natural circumstances are contrary to what His Word says.

If we had faith within us, there would be no need for it to “come” to us by hearing the Word of God.

Something can only come to a place where it does not yet exist.

Faith is not the byproduct of man; it is the fruit or end result of the Word of God. Faith comes from the Word of God, and that is the only place it can come from.

So many Christians suffer when they are going through challenges, and they are sincerely trying to have faith in God’s Word while their outward conditions are screaming contrary to what the Word says. God loves us, and it would be cruel of Him to expect us to believe something when we do not have the ability within ourselves to believe. That’s why it’s...

“Not our responsibility to have faith; it is our responsibility to hear the Word of God, get it into our hearts and keep it there, and when we do that, the Word produces faith that gives us the ability to believe God for the promise in the face of opposing circumstances.”

So the next time you want to experience a promise of God in the midst of challenging circumstances, do not struggle by trying to believe or have faith; just get busy getting the Word of God inside of you. You do that by hearing it, reading it, studying it, confessing it, and meditating upon it. And when you get the Word within, the Word will produce the faith you need to manifest the promise.

Joshua 1:8 explains this exact pattern:

“This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.”

Here is a powerful truth you want to always remember:

“When faith gets within, change without begins.”

You can change your world without by getting the Word within. This is one of the wisdom insights that God gave me that revolutionized every aspect of my life. It is the key secret to miracles. Many people fail to experience a miracle without because they fail to get the Word of God within. If you want to see a miracle on the outside, get the Word on the inside.

4. **Alignment of Your Words:** You are going to need to create some affirmations and faith statements concerning your harvest. Speak forth your prosperity in the face of apparent lack; let your words agree with the Word of God. Do not

allow your words to be a reflection of your current circumstances, let them be a reflection of the Word. Remember, your words have the power to create life or death to your harvest.

“Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.”

Proverbs 18:21

5. **Alignment of Your Thinking:** It is almost humanly impossible to think thoughts of prosperity and increase when your home is going into foreclosure, when you’ve lost your job, or when the overdue bills become unbearable. So what you must do is exchange your natural mind and renew it with the Word of God. Renewing your mind is the only thing that is going to give you peace, hope, and faith in the midst of contrary circumstances. Romans 12:2 tells us not to be conformed to this world (their method of thinking) but be transformed by the renewing of our mind.
6. **Patience:** This is, above all, the hardest part of the Seedtime and Harvest process, especially if you are under severe financial pressure. This process is not God’s fault, it is not testing time—it is the process of creation, and the harsh effects it may play on us is due to our poor stewardship. This is not to say that the enemy will not use this time to try to discourage us, make us doubt, abandon our harvest, and get mad at God, saying, “This stuff doesn’t work!” What do you do during this waiting time, especially when you want to give up and give in? Hang on to these two scriptures:

Let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.”

Galatians 6:9

"Therefore, do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward. For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise."

He.10:35-36

Whatever You Do, Don't Abandon Your Seed

7. **Praise God for The Harvest:** Praise is the language of faith. Praising God has a way of expediting the manifestation of your miracle. When you begin to praise God, it will lift the atmosphere of depression, despair, and fear. Praise produces the atmosphere of joy and peace. What do you do when you are waiting for your harvest? Praise God.

*"I will Bless the Lord at all times;
His praise shall continually be in my mouth."*

Ps.34:1

Everyone knows how to bless the Lord during good times; very few know how to do it at all times!

7 POWERFUL WAYS TO SOW YOUR SEED

*“Sow into a ministry that inspires
your faith for a harvest.”*

1. **Decide what kind of harvest you want.** God gives us the scriptural guidelines and structure on how to give, but most of all, He provides us with the free will to decide the kind of harvest we desire. 2 Co. 9:-6-7. Many people ask God, “How much shall I give?” But He leaves that decision to you based on the kind and size of harvest you desire.
2. **Ask God where to sow.** It is important that we allow God to direct us where we should sow our seed; however, there are safe guidelines that are based on sound reasoning and the Word of God that give us the ability to sow effectively when we do not hear a specific direction from God.

Safe Guidelines for Giving

- a. Bless those who bless you.
- b. Honor those who serve you.
- c. Give to those who inspire you.

- d. Give to those who spiritually feed you.
 - e. Give to the poor.
3. **Sow your seed into a ministry that inspires your faith for a harvest.** Never allow undue pressure or human persuasion from a ministry to influence you to give or demand a certain amount. The place and amount you sow is your decision, and it is between you and the Lord. However, it is of vital importance to take heed and sow into a ministry that inspires you to believe in a harvest. A ministry that supports your faith, joins your faith, and helps you believe in your miracle harvest is always a good place to sow.
4. **Expect a harvest.** Once you give your seed, it is not only scripturally correct to expect God to multiply your seed back to you, but it is also your moral, ethical, and spiritual obligation as a faithful steward of God's resources to do so. Any farmer who would plant natural seed and not expect a harvest back would be considered an unwise and slothful steward of his resources and responsibility.
5. **Sow into a ministry that teaches you the Word of God concerning prosperity.** Ro. 10:17 says that faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. Without hearing the Word of God on the area of financial blessings, you will not know what the will of God is on the subject, will not know what your covenant benefits are, and will not be able to develop faith to fully express your harvest.
6. **The wrong way to sow.** You cannot buy a miracle from God in any shape or form. There are a lot of people who

want to sow large amounts of money on Sunday and live like the devil the rest of the week, hoping that their generous offerings will even the score card. That is not how it works. The book of Proverbs tells us:

*“To do righteousness and justice is more acceptable
to the Lord than sacrifice.”*

Proverbs 21:3

It is better to live the right way and not sow than it is to sow and live the wrong way. The most productive thing to do is to live the right way, while giving the right way. That is the best of both worlds. Do not try to justify living wrong by giving right.

A young man came up to a pastor I know and handed him a tithe envelope. After a brief talk with the man, the pastor started to walk away, when another young man came running up, saying; “Pastor, Pastor, do not take that money’ that money came from Gambling.” The pastor looked at the envelope for a second and then put it into his pocket. The young man replied, “You mean you are going to keep that money?” The pastor said, “Yep, the devil had it long enough; it’s time God starts to use it!”

7. **Sow a thousand-dollar seed.** As a preacher, if you want to have the wrath of the world come against you with vehement anger, set yourself up for relentless false accusations, and be a target for ridicule, just preach the message of the thousand-dollar seed! However, you can break the back of poverty and start the cycle of financial independence with a thousand-dollar seed.

Mike Murdock was invited many years ago to take part in a televised telethon, and the minister was talking about people sowing a thousand-dollar seed. When Dr. Murdock heard that, he said, "Lord, I sure hope there are a lot of millionaires watching tonight, who in the world could afford to give a thousand-dollar seed?" The Lord told him, "I want you to sow a thousand-dollar seed." Dr. Murdock obeyed, even though he did it with an upset stomach, and that seed broke the back of poverty and changed his life and ministry forever.

Every time I have started a major project, God always came to me and asked me to sow a large seed. When we started the Power of Mentorship book series, I was working to pull together all my money to launch the project. Melinda and I were at a drive-in burger place when God spoke into my heart and said, "I want you to plant a thousand-dollar seed." I said, "Please, Lord, not right now. I need a thousand dollars; I do not need to be giving it away!" I wrestled with this the entire time we were in line, and by the time we got to the window to get our food, my stomach was so upset I could not enjoy my food.

Melinda had no idea what was going on with me and the Lord, and I started to get mad at her because she was sitting there enjoying her burger. It was my reasoning mind that was creating the battle, because I knew that God wanted me to sow that seed so that He could abundantly bless this new publishing venture.

When I finally said yes to the Lord, all peace came back to me, and I ate the best burger of my life! The end harvest of that thousand-dollar seed was an 18-book series that has created hundreds of thousands of dollars, and 3 movies with some of the top leading experts in the field of personal growth like Brian Tracy, Bob Proctor, and Vic Johnson.

When we were in the midst of producing our movie, *The Journey*, God once again came to me and said, “Plant a \$1,500 seed.” Of course, I was in the middle of investing money in this movie, and once again I said, “Please, Lord, not now. I need to get money right now, not give it away.” So, I once again had to shut down my reasoning mind, and once I did, I was able to sow that \$1,500 seed with great joy and expectation.

The end result of that \$1,500 seed was the production and sale of the movie surpassed all my hopes, dreams, and expectations beyond my wildest imagination. The seed was big, but small in comparison to the harvest it brought back.

The Secret Behind the Thousand-Dollar Seed

Is there a divine secret, a supernatural insight into a thousand-dollar seed? What is so special about sowing a thousand-dollar seed?

Every ministry I know of that teaches the thousand-dollar seed is always asked the same question: why a thousand-dollar seed, why does it work so powerfully, and is there something secret about it? Although some try to answer and address those questions, I have never heard a good answer.

I was praying late one night, and at about 1:30 in the morning, the Lord spoke to my heart and said, “Would you like to know the answer behind the thousand-dollar seed?”

I said, “Yes, Lord,” and I grabbed my pen and journal and was ready to write. I was ready for this divine revelation that I was sure was going to be so deep that you would need an angel to decode it. This is what the Lord told me:

**10 Seeds Produce a Bigger Crop than 1 Seed;
100 Seeds Produce a Bigger Crop than 10 Seeds;
1,000 Seeds Produce a Bigger Crop than 100 Seeds;
That is why a thousand-Dollar Seed
Produces Such a Big Harvest**

The wisdom of God takes the incomprehensible secrets of the Universe and puts them into a format that a fifth grader can understand. Jesus called this method of communication “parables.”

Sowing a thousand-dollar seed takes faith, and most of the time it never feels good in your stomach and never agrees or makes sense to your reasoning mind. But it always produces an extraordinary harvest. Every time God moves us to sow a seed, it’s because He has a harvest on His mind that He wants to send us.

Remember this: no matter how large of a seed you sow, it is always small in comparison to the harvest it brings back. A seed never leaves our life, only our hand to go into our future to multiply.

THE POWER OF A SEED

"While the earth remains, Seedtime and Harvest, Cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night Shall not cease."

Gen.822

When you get an understanding of the power, potential, function, and assignment of a seed, doubt, fear, and worry about lack and poverty will be drastically eliminated from your mind and heart. Every kind of seed has three instructions encoded in them.

1. **Reproduce after its own kind-** A seed has no other choice but to reproduce itself; it cannot change or morph into another type of seed. An invisible code although undetected by science is undeniable there.
2. **Die when it is planted-** When a seed falls to the ground and dies, in all reality it really is releasing new life. The same is true with your financial seed; once it leaves your hand, you must let it go in order for it to release new life into it. That is why you are not supposed to be concerned about where your money goes after you sow it. If you are worried about what the ministry does with it, your seed is still alive and cannot reproduce.
3. **Multiply-** When a seed is planted, it always comes back with

more. The seed has the command and blueprint of increase inside of it. It is designed with prosperity within its make up. If science could dissect its invisible instructions, they would pull out the gene of abundance.

Once you have a clear understanding of these three functions of a seed, and you plant (sow) a financial seed, you will not be pacing up and down at 3:00 in the morning, praying for God to send you a harvest. With this knowledge, you will know that you are now in the transition from weeping to reaping.

Time

It is called Seedtime and Harvest because it takes seed “time” to grow into a harvest. Do not fall into the trap of abandoning your faith and seed because it takes time to grow. The number one question everyone wants to know is how much time. How long does it take from the time you plant a seed until God sends you back a harvest? I think Oral Roberts gave the best answer I have ever heard. Someone asked him; “How long does it take to get a harvest once you plant a seed?” Without blinking an eye, Oral Roberts smiled and said, “I don’t know, I don’t handle that part of the business.” (God does.)

One of the greatest revelations I have ever learned, which is the same one Oral Roberts, Mike Murdock, Todd Coontz, and every other successful Christian I know has learned, is the Revelation of the Seed.

Never Look at Money as Money Again

Once you understand that a seed reproduces after its own kind and that it always comes back multiplied, you must begin to realize that everything you have is a seed. Never look at money as money again. If you do, that is all it will ever be to you, just money.

But if you change your perspective and realize that money is a seed, and become seed minded, you will realize when you give an offering that you are not giving money, you are giving seed, and seed always

reproduces itself and comes back multiplied. This understanding will boost your faith and strengthen your expectation of a harvest.

A Seed Planted Always Multiplies and Comes Back as More

A seed planted always multiplies and comes back as more. This is a truth that you must embed in the deep recesses of your mind and heart. It must be placed there like a mental tattoo. It has to be one of the core belief structures of your life if you are going to experience the prosperity that God has provided for you.

Having this understanding that a seed planted always multiplies and comes back as more is part of the Revelation of the Seed. You must know that you know, that you know...

Every Time I Sow a Financial Seed, It Comes Back Multiplied

The Importance of Soil

How important is the soil that you plant your financial seed in? It is imperative, a leading factor in the health, vitality, and reproduction of that seed. It greatly affects the harvest, just like these elements affect a natural seed. However, the soil where you plant your financial seed is not the soil you think it is...

Soil for Your Finances

If you asked most Christians, both laity and ministry, they would tell you that the soil for your financial seed is the ministry you give your money to. Although this is a very popular teaching, it is **incorrect**. Yes, we must be good stewards of our income, and it is important to sow into good ministries, but the ministry is not the soil!

"Imploring us with much urgency that we would receive the gift and the fellowship of the ministering to the saints."

2 Co.8:4

The ministry you sow into is a ministry you choose to bless and partner with in their assignment and anointing. It is also one that has mutual benefits because their teaching should be feeding you the Word of God and joining their faith with yours for increase on every level of your life.

*“But by equality, that now at this time your abundance may supply their lack,
that their abundance also may supply your lack –
that there may be equality.”*

2Co.8:14

If a ministry was the soil, your harvest would be dependent upon the merits, deeds, and actions of other people. It would mean your harvest would depend upon what they do.

If the ministry was the soil that determined your harvest, you then would need to become the judge, jury, and investigator of that ministry in order to determine if that is good ground. Do you want that responsibility every time you sow a seed?

It would also mean that ministry would be the one who is your source of return. If a ministry is not the soil, what is? Jesus gave us the answer...

“According to Your Faith Be It unto You.”

**“God never puts your results in the hands of someone else.
They are too important, so He leaves them in your hands.”**

Your faith is the soil that grows your seed. And where does faith abide—in your head or mind? No, faith abides in your heart. It's the condition of your heart that determines if your soil is rocky, stony, shallow, or good ground. Jesus gave us the parable of the sower in Mark Chapter four and listed the four kinds of soil:

1. Wayside Soil. The birds came and devoured it.
2. Stony Ground. The sun scorched it.
3. Thorns. It choked the seed.

4. Good Ground. It multiplies the seed 30, 60, and 100 times.

Jesus then expounds the parable in Mk.4:14-20, letting us know that the four different kinds of soil are the conditions of our heart.

I can have all the faith in the world that God will multiply your seed back to you, but if you do not believe it, my faith does you no good. Or I could be as doubtful as Thomas, but if you believe God is going to increase your seed, my doubt does not hinder your harvest. Why? Because the ministry is not the soil, your faith is!

A ministry is a physical place that gives you the opportunity to store your physical financial seed so that God can multiply it and bring you back a physical harvest according to the soil of your faith.

You decide the size of the seed;

You decide the size of the harvest;

You decide the condition of the soil;

You decide where to store your seed;

And God provides the harvest according to these guidelines.

The Assignment

In Genesis 1:11, it says, “Then God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb that yields seed, and the fruit tree that yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed is in itself, on the earth and it was so.”

What did God do at that moment of time in Scripture? He gave the seed and assignment to reproduce itself after its own kind. That was an instruction, an invisible code placed inside that seed, it was giving seed an assignment.

Since we are made in the image of God in His likeness and were told to have dominion on the earth, what are we supposed to do with our (financial) seeds? We are to give them an assignment.

God told the seed what to do; we are supposed to tell our seed what to do. This is called sowing or planting for a specific cause. It is deciding what kind of harvest you want and then releasing your seed, allowing it to grow in the soil of your faith. This method is also known as Seed-Faith.

Once you understand that your finances are seed, and that financial seeds are exactly like natural seeds and that you can plant your seed for a certain type of harvest, your financial torment will be over.

Will this mean you will never have another financial problem? That depends upon your actions as a sower. Many times when God blesses us financially, we somehow slack up in our sowing because we are so wrapped up in the blessing. If you do not plant, you do not reap, that is the law of seedtime and harvest.

Seed-Faith is giving something you have, to multiply it into something you want. It is releasing what you do have in order to reap what you don't have. It is sowing something you have been given to produce something you have been promised.

GOD ALWAYS PROVIDES SEED TO SOW

One of the most powerful tools God gives us is also one of the most misunderstood topics of the Bible. In fact, for many, it becomes a subject of mental torment, guilt, anger, fear, and every other negative emotion, which is really sad because that is the exact opposite of its purpose. That particular subject is “tithing.”

There is no doubt you are familiar with both sides of the subject of tithing, both the teaching of why we must tithe and the teaching that it is not relevant for the New Testament believer. Rather than throw in my two cents about these two lines of thought and muddy the waters even more, I want to bypass both those views and give you a “fresh new Biblical perspective.”

A Fresh New Look at Tithing

2 Co.9:10 says, “Now may He who supplies seed to the sower...” How and where does God supply that seed? He supplies the seed by blessing the work of your hands, giving you an open haven so you can prosper to the amount and degree you desire. Where He provides seed from is by you taking a portion (10 percent) of your harvest that comes from the result of God blessing the work of your hands. A tithe means

ten percent; therefore, tithing is simply your seed that is based on a percentage of your current harvest.

Tithing is seed based on a percentage of a harvest. An offering is a seed that is not based on the percentage of a harvest.

Tithing is simply a certain percentage (ten percent) of seed from your harvest, and an offering is seed that is not relevant to the percentage of the harvest. The question is not should I tithe or not, the question becomes how big of a harvest do you want? Because the size of your harvest will be determined by the amount of seed you plant. He that sows much reaps much, and those who sow little reap little. Co.9:6

If you have to ask if you should tithe based on gross or net, you don't have the revelation of the seed or understand the dynamics of harvest yet.

Understanding the Seed

Once you have an understanding of the seed and the harvest, and have experienced the rich rewards of this system, your heart will rejoice and cannot wait to be able to take seed to plant from your harvest. Taking ten percent of your seed from your harvest will no longer be an issue full of torment, but one filled with celebration of joy and expectation! Too many Christians today pay their tithes as though it was a bill or required payment from the Big Boss.

Having this inner perspective not only causes your faith to be ineffective, but it gives way to debate, fear, resentment, discouragement, guilt, and utter frustration.

The Wisdom of Giving

The wisdom of giving is simply having an understanding and revelation of the seed and what role it plays in our life to bring prosperity to us. I was having lunch with a doctor friend, and he told me about a local businessman we both knew who had just committed

suicide. It was a horrific event. This businessman owned a very successful furniture store for 30 years in town. At its peak, it was doing 2 million dollars annually.

During the past five years, the business was on a steady decline, and with the recent harsh economy and failure to implement the marketing plans to turn his business around, the company was on the brink of bankruptcy. It was at this financial low point that he decided to end his own life. It would be easy to stand on the outside and judge him as one who loved money and made money his god. This may or may not be true; I think the real cause was not his love for money, but his inability to know how to get his wealth back once he lost it.

For the Christian, we always know and have the opportunity to get our financial fortune back should we lose it. God always gives us the opportunity to get it back. How? Through the power of the seed! You must learn to develop faith in the seed. You can climb out of any financial darkness, you can rebound from any financial crisis and make your way back to the top of the financial mountain through releasing your seed!

God always provides seed to make it back, even in our darkest hour.

Faith is not believing in prosperity in the midst of abundance.

**Faith is believing in prosperity when you are drowning
in the midst of lack.**

How do you know if you are walking in faith? Listen to your language. Are you complaining and griping about the financial pressure you are under? Are you speaking negatively about how long it takes to experience your harvest? Or are you praising God, speaking words of strength and joy?

**Praise is the language of faith;
complaining is the language of fear.**

To praise God and be joyful while in the midst of a financial storm is naturally impossible. When you are up against a wall and unpaid bills are filling up your mailbox every day, and creditors are calling you at work, it is not within your natural power to be joyful and praise God. You cannot help but speak the language of fear.

However, it is possible to be joyful and speak the language of praise in the midst of a severe storm by the supernatural strength called faith.

Faith Harvest

God always provides seed. His Word is the seed that produces faith. Ro.10:17 *"So then faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God."* When you plant God's Word into your heart, you will receive a harvest of faith as a result. And only when we plant and water the Word of God in our heart do we find the supernatural strength to speak the language of praise in the midst of a storm.

If you have no faith, plant faith seeds, which is the Word of God. You can change the world without if you get the Word within. Jesus said, "The Words I speak to you are Spirit, and they are life." Jn.6:63 The Word of God is the seed that produces and releases faith in our heart.

Therefore, you must plant the seed of faith to get a faith harvest.

How do we get the Word within? How do we plant the Word in our heart?

You read it, hear it, speak it, meditate on it, and you do it on a consistent basis. *"Blessed is the man ... his delight is in the Law of the Lord, and in His Law, he meditates day and night."* Psalm 1:1-3

"This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it."

Joshua 1:8.

Peace us the Perfect Atmosphere for Faith to Grow

When under extreme financial pressure and when you are in the midst of a financial storm, the number one thing the enemy is after is your peace. If the enemy can steal your peace, he knows that you will abort your faith and abandon your harvest. However, if you retain your peace, you can make it through any storm. "You will keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You." Isaiah 26:3 Peace is the perfect atmosphere for faith to grow.

Growing Time

Incubation or growing time or what is known as gestation; the time from planting to harvesting is the perfect breeding ground for you to lose your peace. This is why the Bible tells us not to grow weary in well doing (waiting for the harvest) for we shall reap if we faint not. Galatians 6:9

Sow Your Way to the Top

The corporate and entrepreneur systems of the world depend upon fierce marketing and competitive advantages to make it to the top. This system is filled with hard work and leaves many shipwrecked on the wayside, never to reach their goal to the top. However, the way of the giver is based on the supernatural activity of the seed and harvest, knowing that favor is resting upon their life and operating in their life.

This means that whatever you put your hand to begins and continues to prosper in ways that are superior to laborious methods alone. We get our harvest by God sending it "through our labors;" it does not come "from our labors." Phil.4:19 tells us it is God who supplies our needs.

WHAT IS AN OFFERING?

In 2004, the Lord had me gear my teaching and writing gifts to reach the audience of those in the industry of personal growth and the self-help marketplace. This allowed us to work and speak on the platforms of the biggest names in that industry, like Brian Tracy, Vic Johnson, and Bob Proctor just to name a few. I feel blessed and honored to have become friends and associates with all these internationally known top leaders.

As I was finishing up our last movie project with Brian Tracy, I told a number of my colleagues that I was now going to start focusing my attention and teaching back to the Christian community, where my true roots have always been. As I shared that with one nationally known leader, with all true sincerity and honesty, he said, “Wow, Don, that’s great, you will just have to stand up, teach, and pass the bucket. You will make a killing.”

He was not joking or trying to be funny; he was truly revealing the mindset, the paradigms, and perspective of those who are not born again. Another leader who came into one of my Christian teachings said, “That was great, but, dude, it had way too much Bible in it. You

need to tone it down and talk about the universe bringing you stuff.” Once again, here is another wonderful human being who I greatly care about, but who was exposing the mindset of the world.

As both these individuals shared with me their thoughts and insights, I simply smiled and even had to laugh because that is really how the secular world views the church and their finances. I assure you, offerings are not about “Passing the Bucket” and making the preacher rich!

What is an offering? In its most simplistic definition, a New Testament offering is a seed that is used to bless others, while opening the doors of blessing and increase to come into our life. It is the opportunity to bless others while getting blessed ourself.

There was one time when I wanted to conduct one of my meetings and not take up an offering. For whatever reason, it came into my reasoning mind that this would be the wrong thing to do. Then, like Jesus rebuking Peter and telling him to “get behind me, Satan,” the Lord spoke strictly to me and said, “The offering is not for you or about you; it’s for them and about the harvest.”

The world will condemn you for giving money, the reasoning mind will talk you out of giving an offering, your flesh doesn’t want to give up the offering, and Satan does everything he can to stop you from giving an offering. What do all these elements have in common? They are all disconnected from God! Besides that, however, the core reason why Satan does not want you to sow seed is because he knows better than anyone that sowing seed is the number one way God financially blesses His people. If you allow any factor to keep you from sowing, you have allowed that factor to rob you of your harvest.

Different Types of Harvest

Miracle Harvest: A miracle harvest is a harvest that is so big, so magnificent you know it could not have been due to your efforts. An

example of this is when God told Peter to cast in his net, even though Peter had toiled all night and came up empty. Although Peter was doubtful, he was obedient, and the result was an instant catch that was so big it broke his net. Luke 5:6

Perpetual Harvest: Isaac experienced this type of harvest: “The man began to prosper and continued prospering until he became very prosperous.” Genesis 26:13

Instant Harvest: The widow at Zarephath, who Elijah was sent to, found herself on the end of an instant harvest after she gave what God told her to give; “So she went away and did according to the word of Elijah; and she and her household ate for many days.” 1 King 17:15

30, 60, 100-Fold Harvest: These were the types of harvest that Jesus talked about in Mark the fourth chapter, and Isaac is an example of receiving the hundred-fold harvest when he sowed in a land that was suffering from a famine. Genesis 26:12

1,000-Fold Harvest: This is a harvest that you do not hear many people talk about, and that is no doubt why more people do not reap this kind of thousand-fold harvest. “May the Lord God of your fathers make you a thousand times more numerous than you are and bless you as He has promised you.”

Different Types of Money

Labor Money: This is the money we work for and trade our time for. It's called wages, earned money, or a paycheck.

Inherited Money: This money comes from departed relatives that leave you in their will. It comes from their past labors and assets.

Chance Money: This is money that comes by way of lottery, a contest, or a drawing.

Free Money: This is money that someone gives you for no other reason other than they want to bless you and give it to you with no strings attached.

Found Money: An example of this type of money is when Jesus told Peter to fish and that the first fish he catches will have money in its mouth and take that money and go pay out taxes. Matthew 17:24-27

Deceitful Money: This is money that comes by way of greed and takes without giving value in return. It is also money that comes with a curse on it and every type of calamity attached to it. Proverbs 1:19

Miracle Money: This is the kind of money that comes from a direct intervention of heaven and comes from unexpected sources under the most extraordinary types of circumstances.

Harvest Money: This is by far the most predictable and blessed money because it is a direct result of adherence and obedience to the system God placed within His Word called Seedtime and Harvest. Genesis 8:22

Spiritual or Scriptural?

Giving to God and not expecting anything in return sounds spiritual, but it simply is not scriptural. God has always made a provision for His people to prosper in good times and in bad times, and it has always been by way of sowing seed. When Jacob was broke and on the run and had nothing but a walking stick and a bad sunburn, he found the way out of those conditions:

Jacob made a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and keep me in this way that I am going, and give me bread to eat and clothing to put on, so that I come back to my father's house in peace, then the Lord shall be my God ... and all that you give me I will surely give a tenth to you." Genesis 28:20-22

Warning

If you are going to escape the harshness of the financial turmoil that is upon us, you will have to become a diligent seeker of seed — seed that you may sow in order to sustain you now and prosper you in the future.

There is a way to escape the torment of financial pressure and worry and become confident and assured that your provision and prosperity are secured. Our prosperity and provision are not in the hands of mankind, the marketplace, or even in the hands of God. Your provision and prosperity are in your hands. The question is, will you release the seed to receive the promise?

THE SECERT OF PROVISION

Provision: *“They shall not hunger nor thirst; neither shall the heat or sun smite them; for He that hath mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall He guide them.”* Isaiah 49:10

Provision Where There is No Provision

Isaac sowed during a devastating famine and received a 100-fold return. This is called *“provision in dead ground.”* Genesis 26:12

Joseph saved during the seven years of plenty so that they would have supply during the seven years of famine. This is called *“provision in a dry land.”* Genesis 41:33-34

The disciples toiled all night and caught nothing; then Jesus told them to cast their net on the other side. The take was so large it caused their nets to break. This is called *"provision in an empty boat."* Luke 5:5

Jesus fed 5,000 people with only 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish. This is called *"provision for many from a basket of few."* John 6:9

God caused the food supply of a widow who was about to die of starvation to multiply, increase, and not run out. This is called *"provision in the valley of death."* 1Kings 17:16

All these are examples of provision where there was no provision, yet God made a way! What was the common denominator among all of them that opened the door of provision? They all sowed a seed.

When you face a financial wilderness experience, you must keep on believing, keep sowing seed, keep expecting, keep confessing your harvest, and continue to praise and worship God for the promise because the harvest always comes.

**Satan is the cause of lack and poverty, but many times we
are the one who creates it in our life.**

Most, not all, but a large percentage of the time when we experience a financial crisis, it is of our doing and making. When a Christian finds him or herself in financial trouble, you can usually trace it back to the following reasons:

1. **Poor stewardship habits.** No self-discipline on how to spend and save money, spending more than one earns. How does a man who makes \$50,000 a month go broke and

bankrupt? He spends \$60,000. A month! This is the true story of many high-earning individuals. No matter how much money you earn or how little you earn, without good stewardship habits, you will find yourself in financial trouble.

“Many people have the false idea that prosperity means that you will have an unlimited amount of cash to spend as freely and carefree as you desire without any spending restraints.”

2. **Failure to sow seed.** Without sowing financial seed, it is impossible to reap a continuous harvest from God. Every opportunity to give is an opportunity to receive. It is important to state here that there is a vast difference between a harvest from God and a harvest from the world. A harvest from God comes without sorrow, heartache, and trouble.

*“The blessing of the Lord makes one rich,
and He adds no sorrow with it.”*

Proverbs 10:22

A harvest from the world is filled with emptiness and every type of heartache known to man, including violence, abuse, addictions of every sort, and many times ends in suicide. This is a description and sad reality of a financial harvest that many unsaved people in the entertainment industry experience.

This is why you should not try to use the excuse that you know of sinners who do not give to God and still prosper financially. That type of harvest is not one that usually does one good.

3. **Refuse to grow.** Money is the result of the problems you solve for people. If you are not willing to grow and expand your service to mankind, you will continue to earn what you are now earning. The marketplace is paying you what your contribution is worth to them. They pay a janitor \$13 an hour for their contribution to solve cleaning problems; they pay attorneys \$300 an hour for their contribution to solve legal problems. Both Joseph and Daniel were rewarded with abundant wealth because of their contribution to solve the dream problem of kings.
4. **Sin that is not repented.** Sin simply means missing the mark—the mark that allows all good things to come our way and live a life filled with peace, happiness, fulfillment and joy. We all sin, make mistakes, do things we regret, and fall into the snares of temptation, no matter how close we walk with the Lord. There are times we just miss it. As one man said, “After I got saved, I did not become sinless, but I did sin less.”

When we do miss it, the important thing is to confess it, repent (change), and ask God for forgiveness immediately. Do not allow that sin to remain in your life and dwell there.

“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

I John 1:9

Sin that we allow to remain in our life will rob and eat away at our money, health, and relationships like cancer; eventually, if not taken care of, it will lead to our utter destruction and shame.

“Poverty and shame will come to him who disdains correction.”

Proverbs 13:18

5. **Lack of knowledge.** Some folks simply do not understand that God not only wants them to prosper financially. He has made ample provision for them to prosper. Many grew up in a church environment where they were taught that money and riches were wrong to have or to seek—that money is a worldly and an unspiritual subject.

God's very first conversation with mankind was about increase and multiplying.

"Then God blessed them, and God said to them, 'Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it.'"

Genesis 1:28

The very first words He ever spoke to mankind were on increase and multiplication. Out of all the things God could have chosen to speak to them about, He chose to talk about increase! The first word my parents ever spoke to me was "Goo-Goo-Gaga."

You cannot prosper if you do not know that God wants you to prosper and has made a way for you to prosper. "My people are destroyed for lack of Knowledge." Hosea 4:6

6. **Lack of faith.** Nothing happens without faith. You won't start your car if you do not believe it will start, you will not sit in a chair if you do not believe it will hold you, and you will not start a project if you do not believe you can do it. You will not experience a harvest if you do not believe it is coming. I understand it is hard to believe in increase when they are towing your car away, when your bank account is overdrawn, and you are pacing the floor at 3:00 a.m. because you have no idea where you are going to get the rent money from that is due at 10:00 a.m.

The good news is that you are not required to produce faith; you are just required to hear the Word, and the Word will produce the faith you need. God's Word is a faith factory. The factory of faith resides in God's Word, not in your head. "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God." Romans 10:17

7. **Growing weary.** It is called Seedtime and Harvest because it takes time for a seed to grow into a harvest. It is not easy, especially when you are under financial pressure, to wait and wait in faith for the harvest once you plant your seed. During that waiting time, when the seed is growing, it creates a perfect environment to attack your mind, your faith, your hope and vehemently accuse God's Word for not working. Unless you keep yourself immersed in God's Word, those attacks will cause you to grow weary, and you will abandon your seed and harvest.

Make sure when you are tempted to give up on your seed and harvest, that you cling to Galatians 6:9, which states, "And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart."

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THE THOUSAND-DOLLAR SEED

Nothing sounds more hypocritical, dishonest, and echoes the sound of false doctrine than hearing a preacher ask people to sow a thousand-dollar seed. Nothing stirs up more resentment, anger, animosity, and false accusation than those words: sow a thousand-dollar seed. Before you jump onto this bandwagon of rage when you hear these words, I encourage you to stop and carefully and prayerfully consider these important points.

Nothing stirred up more anger, resent, and hatred and sounded more like hearsay and false doctrine to the Pharisees than when Jesus proclaimed He was the Son of God and had the power to forgive sins. Yet it was the absolute truth that set men free.

The Bible clearly states that God's ways are not our ways, nor are His thoughts our thoughts, for as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are His ways higher than our ways.

When Jesus told Peter that He would wash his feet, that sounded wrong, even to Peter, and Peter responded, "Lord, you will never wash my feet." Now that response from Peter sounded correct. The reasoning mind says, "Come on, the

Master, the Son of God washing the feet of Peter? You know that is not right.” Yet, Jesus told Peter if He did not wash his feet, he had no part of Him. What sounds wrong to the world is correct to God.

There is a way that seems right to a man...

What sounds wrong to the world and the carnal reasoning mind is right in the government of the Kingdom of God.

As believers, we do not operate in a democracy (the people rule); we operate in a “Theocracy.” -God Rules

The widow that is starving to death, with her son on his deathbed, is ready to cook her last meal and then lay down with her son to die. Then she finds God coming to her to deliver her from those dire conditions. Did He send her a choir group with a truckload of food from the market? Did He drop apples from the sky or bring her baskets full of goodies? No, that is how the world and natural carnal mind would have done it.

Instead, He sends her a hungry preacher that asks her to give him an offering of the last small piece of food she has left. Does anything sound so crazy, insane, or wrong? That stirs up anger and resentment. Of course, these are the reactions of the world and those who do not know the Word of God or the ways of God.

But that was the exact method God used to bring her a Miracle Harvest, an Instant Harvest, and a Perpetual Harvest! That method not only solved her famine problem, it restored her confidence problem. Whenever we face dire financial crises, the enemy always comes to attack our confidence in God and His Word.

Now, with that being said, I do believe that sowing a thousand-dollar seed is available to “anyone,” but it is not for “everyone.” Sowing a thousand-dollar seed is for those who:

- * want to break the back of poverty in their life;
- * desire to live a large life that impacts the lives of people around the globe;
- * are not willing to sit on the sideline but desire to take an active role in the expansion of the Kingdom of God on this earth in these last days;
- * are ready to experience wealth creation and financial flow in their life.

Warning

“Sowing a thousand-dollar seed is like planting an atomic seed, and many are not ready to handle that size of harvest and blessing it will bring into their life.”

Many times when we need to sow a thousand-dollar seed the most, we want to sow it the least. Sowing a thousand-dollar seed is hard on the reasoning mind and it’s hard on the stomach. It requires you to tap into your bank of faith more than your bank account. Satan will stir up every ounce of doubt, fear, unbelief, anger, excuse, and sound reasoning that lies within your mind when you decide to sow a thousand-dollar seed.

Aren’t you supposed to feel good when you give? Not when you are giving in a time of need to break the back of lack in your life. Facing the problem of financial crises is not easy; implementing the solution is not easy, either.

When I launched the Power of Mentorship book series, God asked me first to plant a thousand-dollar seed. I needed to do

this the most, but I wanted to do it the least. In fact, I told God, “Lord, please, not right now, don’t ask me this, because I need a thousand dollars—I do not need to give a thousand dollars.”

Yet, I knew that was my flesh, reasoning mind and the cheerleading group of demons from hell trying to convince me that sowing a thousand-dollar seed was the worst thing I could do. I told you earlier in this book of the Miracle Harvest that came about from that thousand-dollar seed I sowed to launch our book series. It has far exceeded a hundred-fold return and went into the thousand-fold return!

The Secret Behind the Thousand-Dollar Seed

Is there a divine secret, a supernatural insight to a thousand-dollar seed? What is so special about sowing a thousand-dollar seed?

Every ministry I know of that teaches the thousand-dollar seed is always asked the same questions: why a thousand-dollar seed, why does it work so powerfully, and is there something secret about it? Although some try to answer and address those questions, I have never heard a good answer.

I was praying late one night, and about 1:30 in the morning, the Lord spoke to my heart and said, “Would you like to know the answer behind the thousand-dollar seed?”

I said, “Yes, Lord,” and I grabbed my pen and journal and was ready to write. I was ready for this divine revelation that I was sure was going to be so deep that you would need an angel to decode it. This is what the Lord told me:

10 Seeds Produce a Bigger Crop than 1 Seed.

100 Seeds Produce a Bigger Crop than 10 Seeds.

1,000 Seeds Produce a Bigger Crop than 100 Seeds.

And that is why a thousand-dollar seed produces such a big harvest.

The wisdom of God takes the incomprehensible secrets of the universe and puts them into a format that a fifth grader can understand. Jesus called this method of wisdom communication “parables.”

Where should you plant a thousand-dollar seed? Sow it into a ministry that inspires your faith for a Miracle Harvest.

The next time you hear a preacher ask you to plant a thousand-dollar seed and you find yourself getting angry or turned off, just say to yourself:

“Boy, the devil sure wants me to stay broke and keep the blessings of God out of my life!”

Have you ever been there, having a brook that was providing everything for you and then, out of nowhere, the brook dried up? Perhaps you are there now, looking for provision from a dry riverbed that once flowed with abundance. What the heck happened; but more important, what do you do now?

There are many types of brooks in our life, brooks of relationships, health, business, and money, to name a few, and they are designed to

flow all good things into our life. However, they are subject to going dry.

It is like God giving us wings to soar with the eagles! We love it, and we get used to it, depend on it, expect it, and eventually take it for granted. Then one day, we are soaring high in the sky and all of a sudden, our darn wings fall off, and we yell, “Ooh no, now what?”

What Do You Do When Your Brook Dries Up?

You rejoice, because when your brook dries up, that is a signal that your next miracle provision is ready to show up! When your brook dries up, God is letting you know that your next miracle is just around the corner—it’s coming your way, and this new brook is better than the one that just dried up.

“Then the word of the Lord came to him, saying, “Arise, go to Zarephath, I have commanded a widow there to provide for you.”

1Kings 17:9

Right when the brook dried up for Elijah, his next brook showed up!

What Do You Do When...

Your brook dries up, like it did for Elijah?

Your boat is about to sink, like it was for the disciples in a sea storm?

Your good fortune runs out and you are sent to a lion’s den, like Daniel?

Rejoice, because when those events occur, they are signals that something better is going to show up in your life!

Remember, God speaks to your heart, while the enemy speaks to your mind.

Faith resides in your heart; fear resides in your head.

The Secret of Provision

There is no doubt that millions of people around the globe, and hundreds of thousands of people here in the United States are

experiencing financial hard times. Earlier in this book, I shared an experience Melinda and I had, and it bears repeating.

Recently, we drove past the house of a very close friend who lived there for over 20 years, only to see it empty and neglected, the result of financial loss and hard times.

The pain of seeing that empty house and knowing the anguish and untold heartache our friends had to experience moved us deeply. The Bible relates many things to seeds:

His Word to a seed: Mark 4:14 "The sower sows the Word."

Money to a seed: 2 Corinthians 9:6 "He that sows bountifully will also reap bountifully."

Mankind to a seed: "And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed." Genesis 3:15

Food to a seed: "See, I have given you every herb that yields seed." Genesis 1:29

Actions, thoughts, intents to a seed: “Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.” Galatians 6:7

Once you understand the Law of the Seed and realize that everything you need, desire, or possibly want is locked inside of a seed, you will never fear lack again. You will know how to overcome lack and tap into the everflowing river of provision.

*Honor the Lord with your possessions and with the first fruits
of all your increase; so your barns will be filled with plenty,
and your vats will overflow with new wine.*

Proverbs 3:9-10

You can escape financial hard times and have ample provision for the present and the future if you simply follow the plan of sowing and reaping, by releasing the seed and receiving the promise! Always sow your seed into a ministry that inspires your faith for a harvest.

Faith is a powerful magnetic force that pulls the blessings of God to you.

Your seed unlocks every provision you need. As long as you plant seed, you will have provision and prosper in any economy, good or bad. The Secret of Provision is in the seed that is in your hand.

Provision Where There is No Provision

Many of you reading this feel like you are stuck and stranded in the desert—a hard place that feels like there is no way out. But God has three mighty things for you that will turn your desert into an oasis.

Guidance: “I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you shall go; I will guide you with My eye.” Psalm 32:8

Hope: “Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.” Romans 15:13

Provision: *"They shall not hunger nor thirst; neither shall the heat or sun smite them; for He that hath mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall He guide them."* Isaiah 49:10

Provision Where There is No Provision

Isaac sowed during a devastating famine and received a 100-fold return. This is called *"provision in dead ground."* Genesis 26:12

Joseph saved during the seven years of plenty so that they would have supply during the seven years of famine. This is called *"provision in a dry land."* Genesis 41:33-34

The disciples toiled all night and caught nothing; then Jesus told them to cast their net on the other side. The take was so large it caused their nets to break. This is called *"provision in an empty boat."* Luke 5:5

Jesus fed 5,000 people with only 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish. This is called *"provision for many from a basket of few."* John 6:9

God caused the food supply of a widow who was about to die of starvation to multiply, increase, and not run out. This is called *"provision in the valley of death."* 1Kings 17:16

All these are examples of provision where there was no provision, yet God made a way! What was the common denominator among all of them that opened the door of provision? They all sowed a seed.

Isaac sowed seed into the ground.

Joseph sowed seed into the vats.

Peter sowed the use of his boat to Jesus.

The lad sowed his small lunch of 5 loaves and two fish. The widow sowed her last meal to Elijah.

God took their seed and turned it into supernatural provision where there was no natural provision in sight.

**God will supply you with provision

Sow a seed for your impossible and watch God open doors to make it possible! God always does His part; He just waits for us to do our part. Your provision is contained within your seed. Release the Seed and Receive the Promise.
